The Health Sciences Annex building on Centralia College's campus has been demolished to make room for the planned TransAlta Commons, a 70,000-square-foot building scheduled to open in January 2017.

The building housed the Center of Excellence for Clean Energy.

The new commons aims to replace many of the functions currently available at the student center. The three-story building, which was proposed in 2007, will feature a multipurpose room, a bookstore, a planetarium, food services, a student-run cafe, the multicultural center, a welcome desk, conference rooms, and offices for student government and programs, among other things.
