

AAUW Offers Scholarships to Female College Students

Applications for two college scholarships for area women for the 2015-16 academic year are currently available from the American Association of University Women, Lewis County branch. Applications deadline is Feb. 14, 2015.

The Dr. Kate Gregg Scholarship provides full tuition to Centralia College to a woman who will be a sophomore at Centralia College in the fall of 2015.

A \$1,000 tuition scholarship will be awarded to a woman who will be a junior or senior at an accredited four-year college or university for the 2015 fall quarter.

Applicants must be a graduate of a high school within the Centralia College district (Lewis County, but including Rochester) or have been a resident of Lewis County for at least the past two years. Applicants must have a strong record in college academic courses and show financial need.

The Dr. Kate Gregg Scholarship is funded by proceeds from the Lewis County branch's annual book sale, which occurs at the Lewis County Mall in March. The award has been given since 1955.
